Practical Information Regarding continuing education credits at the NCBC

PECI is a registered auditor with the American Institute of Architects (AIA) in the Continuing Education System (CES) program. Conference attendees may receive CEU credits based on their individual session or workshop attendance. For details and available credits, please read the information below. 1. A packet of information on CEU's will be available at the registration desk for anyone who is interested in receiving credit for their attendance. This includes:
 - a. ***An instruction sheet.*** Please make sure to read it carefully. It will include necessary information regarding the CEU's and how to obtain your credits.
 - b. ***A C-1 Form-*** this is list of all the sessions and their available credits. You must sign it and return it to registration at the conference or you can fax it to us and a contact name and number will be provided.
 - c. ***Conference Summary-*** outlines the learning objectives of the conference, available credits, etc.
2. Credits are based on individual session attendance, not overall conference attendance. For example, for every 90-minute session attended 1.5 hours of credit are earned.
3. Attendees cannot attend two halves of two concurrent sessions. Credit will not be given for either. Any C-1 form that is not dated and signed will not receive credit.
4. Attendees will receive a certificate awarding them their credits within two weeks of the last day of the conference.
